WHEREAS, Charles T. Carnahan will retire as Executive Officer of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, on September 1, 1971; and

WHEREAS, such contributions by Mr. Carnahan are deserving of special recognition; now, therefore be it

their appreciation for, and recognition of, his service to the State of California; and be it further


RESOLVED, that the members of this board do hereby extend their warmest wishes to "Charlie" for a happy and satisfying future; and be it further
