

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 72-50

AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT NO. 1-2-71 WITH KAISER ENGINEERS TO INCLUDE A WATER QUALITY SURVEY OF THE TRUCKEE RIVER

WHEREAS:

1. The State and Regional Boards need information on the effect of waste discharges on the quality of water in the Truckee River.
2. An intensive survey of existing water quality in the Truckee River is required before an evaluation of the effect of a waste discharge on water quality in the Truckee River can be made.
3. The Environmental Protection Agency is developing a mathematical model of the Truckee River which will be able to use data from the Truckee River water quality survey to predict changes in water quality in the Truckee River resulting from the discharge of treated wastewater to the Truckee River.
4. That Kaiser Engineers is developing the Basin Plan for planning area No. 6A, the North Lahontan Basin, under Standard Agreement No. 1-2-71 and can conduct the water quality survey of the Truckee River if the Agreement is amended to so provide at a cost to the State of not to exceed \$53,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board enter into an amendment to Standard Agreement No. 1-2-71 with Kaiser Engineers for a survey of water quality in the Truckee River in an amount not to exceed \$53,000.
2. That the Chief, Division of Administrative Services be authorized to execute the Amendment to the Agreement on behalf of the Board.
