WHEREAS:

1. AB 1691 (Chapter 1315 Stats. 72) provides for certification of supervisors and operators of wastewater treatment plants in accordance with regulations to be adopted by the State Board.
2. Said legislation provides for an advisory committee with specified qualifications to review proposed regulations and make recommendations.
