RESOLUTION NO. 73-23

AMENDMENTS TO 1967 INTERSTATE WATER
QUALITY CONTROL PLANS AND POLICIES

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to Section 303(a)(1) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, the Environmental Protection Agency requested the State Water Resources Control Board to amend or modify certain interstate water quality control policies.
2. The changes requested by the Environmental Protection Agency included:
 - a. Revision of dissolved oxygen objective for Dominguez Channel;
 - b. Revision of beneficial uses for Dominguez Channel and Santa Barbara Harbor;
 - c. Addition of bacteriological objectives expressed as fecal coliforms for interstate streams of North Coast, Lahontan, and Colorado River Basin regions, and all coastal and tidal waters.
3. The State Board, after adequate notice, held a public hearing on April 9, 1973, to receive testimony on the changes requested by the Environmental Protection Agency.
4. After review of the record before the Board, including oral and written testimony on the changes requested by the Environmental Protection Agency, the Board finds that the requested changes are appropriate and proper.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Board hereby amends the 1967 Interstate Water Quality Control Plans and Policies as requested by the Environmental Protection Agency.
2. The amendments shall supersede all less restrictive provisions of existing water quality control plans and policies of the State Board and the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards.
