ACCEPTANCE OF LATE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS STATEMENT
AND CHANGE OF PRIORITY FOR THE COURTLAND SANITATION
DISTRICT

WHEREAS:


1. The Courtland Sanitation District did not meet the deadline for filing its 1972-73 Availability of Funds Statement due to failure of its Bond Election;
2. The District was informed on July 12, 1973, that funds could be made available by the River Delta Unified School District as a portion of new school construction scheduled for the summer of 1974;
3. The District must inform the School by September 30, 1973, of its ability to construct the wastewater facilities.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the District's late Availability of Funds Statement be accepted and the project be removed from Priority Class H on the Grant Priority List and be placed in Priority Class A.
