RESOLUTION NO. 74-52

DELEGATIONS OF AUTHORITY TO CERTIFY APPLICATIONS FOR AREAWIDE WASTE TREATMENT MANAGEMENT PLANNING ASSISTANCE AND AREAWIDE WASTE TREATMENT MANAGEMENT PLANS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Governor has delegated to the Board those powers and duties conferred upon the Governor by Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972.
- 2. Regulations proposed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regarding grant assistance for areawide waste treatment management planning under Section 208 provide that, as part of an application for grant assistance, a statement of certification or refusal of certification of the application be submitted by the chief officials of the reviewing agency designated by the Governor.
- 3. Section 208(b)(1) and proposed EPA regulations require that the Governor certify each initial areawide waste treatment management plan prior to submittal of the plan to the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency.
- 4. Section 208(b)(3) requires that areawide waste treatment management plans be certified annually by the Governor or his designee as being consistent with applicable basin plans.
- orderly and efficient conduct of the business of the Board will be promoted by delegation of the authority to certify or refuse to certify applications for areawide planning assistance and areawide waste treatment management plans.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Officer be authorized to certify or to refuse to certify, on behalf of the Board, applications for areawide planning

assistance and areawide waste treatment management plans prepared and submitted as a result of Section 208 of the 1972 Amendments to the Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
