STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-69

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO PERFORM PAIRED STATION MONITORING WORK ON THE LOWER AMERICAN RIVER

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has requested monitoring of specified parameters at paired stations on the lower American River.
- 2. The Department of Water Resources (DWR) can perform the National Water Quality Surveillance System paired station monitoring in F. Y. 1974-75.
- 3. The Board's staff has submitted a proposal acceptable to EPA and EPA has committed \$14,600 of their General Operational contract funds for that purpose.
- 4. The lower station (American River at Sacramento Water Plant) has been designated as part of the State's primary network for monitoring specified parameters at a lesser frequency than required for the National Water Quality Surveillance System.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That this Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to negotiate and execute contracts for paired station sampling and laboratory analysis work on the lower American River as follows:

- a. With EPA to receive \$14,600 of federal funds for the work; and
- b. With DWR in an amount not to exceed \$18,200, including EPA's \$14,600 and up to \$3,600 of General Funds from the F. Y. 1974-75 budget.
