STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 74-83

COMMENDING RADIO AND TELEVISION STATIONS THAT ASSISTED IN PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROGRAM FOR BASIN PLANNING

WHEREAS, an effective water quality control program depends upon the participation of the public in the decision making process; and

WHEREAS, a large number of California radio and television stations donated significant amounts of public service time in the effort to inform the public of hearings on Comprehensive Water Quality Control Plans; and

WHEREAS, the value of public service time donated exceeded \$50,000 in equivalent paid commercial time; and

WHEREAS, the public service announcements played a significant role in increasing the public's awareness of the basin planning effort and stimulating participation in the debate of crucial water quality issues.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the State Water Resources Control Board extends its sincere appreciation to the broadcast media of California for its cooperation and service to the public's involvement in the water quality control program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to each participating radio and television station in California with a letter of appreciation.
