Resolution No. 75-62

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO PREPARE, SIGN AND FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR SEVERAL MINOR CHANGES IN THE DEMONSTRATION GRANT FOR EROSION CONTROL AUTHORIZED BY RESOLUTION NO. 74-53

WHEREAS:

1. The Federal Environmental Protection Agency awarded a Demonstration Grant No. S803181-01 for a three-year study "Demonstration of Erosion and Sediment Control Technology" to the State Board on July 5, 1974.
2. On April 1, 1974 a Negative Declaration was distributed for review at the State Clearinghouse (SCH 74041518) in accordance with the requirements of OMB Circular A-95, the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 USC 4321) and the California Environmental Policy Act of 1970 (CEQA). A Notice of Determination was filed on August 12, 1974 pursuant to CEQA.
3. The proposal for the Erosion and Sediment Control Demonstration identified the Lake Tahoe drainage basin as an area for a possible expansion of the erosion control activities from the initial study area, Northstar-at-Tahoe.
4. The staff of the State Board proposed to EPA to modify the initial study to include an evaluation and demonstration of a series of different erosion control measures in the Lonely Gulch watershed in the Lake Tahoe drainage basin of El Dorado County.
5. EPA approved the proposed minor changes in the demonstration grant in a letter dated March 11, 1975.
6. The proposed minor changes in the demonstration grant are categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA in accordance with Section 15104 and Section 15106 of the State EIR Guidelines (California Administrative Code, Title 14, Division 6, Chapter 3).

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board authorizes the Executive Officer or any person delegated by the Executive Officer to prepare, sign, and file with the Secretary of the Resources Agency, a Notice of Exemption in accordance with Section 15074 of the State EIR Guidelines.
