STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 76-29

REVIEW OF ACTION OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, CENTRAL VALLEY REGION, REGARDING DISCHARGE OF RAW SEWAGE TO THE SACRAMENTO RIVER BY THE CITY OF RED BLUFF.

WHEREAS:

- 1. On February 27, 1976, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board), conducted a hearing regarding discharge of raw sewage to the Sacramento River by the City of Red Bluff in violation of applicable waste discharge requirements.
- 2. After hearing, the Regional Board declined to refer the matter of said raw sewage discharges to the Sacramento River to the Attorney General for action.
- 3. After consideration of the circumstances surrounding the aforementioned raw sewage discharges, it appears to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) that the failure of the Regional Board to refer the aforementioned matter to the Attorney General should be reviewed by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will review, on its own motion, the failure of the Regional Board to refer the aforementioned matter to the Attorney General.
