BOARD ACCEPTANCE OF REPORT: "COOPERATIVE STRIPED BASS STUDY - FIRST PROGRESS REPORT", PREPARED BY THE FOUNDATION FOR OCEAN RESEARCH (STANDARD AGREEMENT 9-030-400-1)

WHEREAS:


1. On August 16, 1979, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted Resolution 79-70 to establish a study to investigate the effects of water pollution on the San Francisco Bay-Delta striped bass fishery.
2. The above study is a cooperative effort among the National Marine Fisheries Service, California Department of Fish and Game, and State Board and named the Cooperative Striped Bass Study (COSBS).
3. Expertise in oceanography, fisheries, and toxicology was needed to develop the COSBS project and to establish cooperative arrangements amongst participating government agencies.
4. On behalf of the State Board, the Executive Director executed Standard Agreement 9-030-400-1 with the Foundation for Ocean Research for a total of \$28,000 to provide technical and management consulting services for COSBS.
5. The Foundation for Ocean Research met the obligations of contract 9-030-400-1 and submitted a First Progress Report of COSBS activities performed since October 1, 1979, to March 1980, as required by the contract.
6. The services provided by the Foundation for Ocean Research were significant to the establishment and direction of the COSBS.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board accepts the report "Cooperative Striped Bass Study - First Progress Report" prepared by the Foundation for Ocean Research in fulfillment of Standard Agreement No. 9-030-400-1.
