## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-5

APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF
A GRANT FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)
TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO
MINORITY AND WOMEN OWNED BUSINESSES (MBE/WBE)

## WHEREAS:

- 1. For the last three years the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has contracted with a firm to assist Clean Water Grant Program grantees in the hiring of Minority Business Enterprises.
- 2. EPA's source of funds for the contract has been curtailed.
- 3. The contracted services has proven very effective.
- 4. It is desirable to advertise and execute a new contract for MBE and WBE services.
- 5. EPA can make Clean Water Act facilities planning (201) funds available to the State for contracting for subject services.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to submit an application for and accept a Federal grant of approximately \$750,000 for providing MBE/WBE services, subject to approval by appropriate State control agencies.
