## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-13

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A MANAGEMENT AGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE U. S. FOREST SERVICE (FOREST SERVICE)

### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Forest Service has completed a water quality management plan for National Forest System (NFS) lands in California.
- 2. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) has certified the plan to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
- 3. EPA has approved the plan.
- 4. Forest Service has the authority to implement the plan.
- 5. Forest Service is committed to implementation of the plan.
- 6. On August 16, 1979, the State Board designated the Forest Service as the management agency for all activities on NFS lands effective upon execution of the proposed management agency agreement and authorized the Executive Director to negotiate a management agency agreement with the U.S. Forest Service.
- 7. A satisfactory management agency agreement has been negotiated with the U. S. Forest Service.
