STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-27

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES TO OPERATE THE STATE BOARD'S PRIMARY WATER QUALITY MONITORING NETWORK.

WHEREAS:

- The State Board requires baseline and trend water quality data at key locations statewide to assist in defining water quality problems and issues and in providing water quality assessments to the Regional Boards.
- The State Board has coordinated design of its Primary Water Quality Monitoring Network with the Department of Water Resources and U.S. Geological Survey water quality monitoring programs and with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
- Supplemental monitoring beyond the existing Department of Water Resources program is needed to meet the monitoring needs of the State Board's Primary Network and EPA's Basic Water Monitoring Program.
- The Department of Water Resources has the staff and technical capability to provide the specified services and desires to provide such services to the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of Water Resources for water quality monitoring for an amount not to exceed \$185,200 in F.Y. 1981-82 Bond Fund monies and \$29,800 in F.Y. 81 Federal 106 Grant monies, subject to approval of the proposed F.Y. 1981-82 budget, for the period July 1, 1981 to June 30, 1982.
