## RESOLUTION NO. 81-29

### FINAL STATE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (PROPOSITION 2) PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Clean Water and Water Conservation Bond Law of 1978 (Proposition 2) contained provisions for the expenditure of up to \$50 million to fund water pollution control, water conservation and wastewater reclamation needs in the State.
- 2. The Board designated this as the State Assistance Program (Proposition 2).
- 3. On July 17, 1980, the Board adopted a Tentative Project Priority List for the State Assistance Program. That list contained Priority "A" grant recommendations for 34 projects totaling \$56,194,756.
- 4. The applicants for those 34 projects were given until December 31, 1980, to complete and submit their final grant applications.
- 5. Staff has reviewed the final grant applications submitted by the applicants and other pertinent information and recommends funding of 29 of these projects for a total grant amount of \$49,553,924.

# THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board intends to grant up to \$50 million to fund needed water pollution control, water conservation and wastewater reclamation projects in the state.
- 2. That the Board adopt the attached Final State Assistance Program (Proposition 2) Project Priority List containing 29 projects for a total grant amount of \$49,553,924 with the stipulation that the various special conditions mandated by the Board be included in the grant agreements to be executed between the grantees and the Board.
