STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-33

AUTHORIZING INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 0-083-180-0 BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES (DWR) FOR A STUDY OF MINERAL INCREMENTS IN WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin established a Mineral Source Control Program. Part of the Plan requires control of mineral increases during the use of water.
- 2. The Basin Plan documented increases in total dissolved solids content during water use.
- 3. A number of other mineral constituents are of concern within the Santa Ana River Basin.
- 4. This study would provide the necessary documentation of these mineral increases.
- 5. The Department of Water Resources is the appropriate agency to conduct this study and has agreed to undertake the project.
- 6. Costs for this study have been budgeted from the Bond Fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board's Executive Director, or any person delegated by the Executive Director, be authorized to approve Interagency Agreement No. 0-083-180-0 between the Board and the Department of Water Resources in an amount not to exceed \$53,000 of Bond Funds for a study of mineral increments in the Santa Ana Region.
