STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-37

RATIFYING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S ACCEPTANCE OF A CLEAN LAKES GRANT FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR LAKE TAHOE AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH LOCAL AND STATE AGENCIES TO PERFORM NECESSARY REMEDIAL EROSION CONTROL PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

- The Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan requires construction of remedial erosion control projects using Clean Lakes grants and other sources of funding.
- 2. The State Board submitted an application for Clean Lakes grant funding for erosion control at Lake Tahoe to the Environmental Protection Agency.
- 3. The individual projects included in the grant applications are based on a Lake Tahoe Remedial Erosion and Urban Runoff Control Project Priority List adopted by the Lahontan Regional Board. The list was prepared on the basis of submissions by public agencies and adopted after opportunity for public participation.
- 4. The grant application has been approved by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency in compliance with Federal Office of Management and Budget Circular A-95.
- 5. The Environmental Protection Agency has offered the State Board a Clean Lakes grant of \$946,934. The offer has been accepted by the Executive Director.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the State Board ratifies the Executive Director's acceptance of the Lake Tahoe Clean Lakes grant from the Environmental Protection Agency.
- 2. That the Executive Director is authorized to negotiate and execute contracts with local governments and districts in the Lake Tahoe Basin, with other State agencies, and with the University of California to perform the work funded under the Clean Lakes grant.
