STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-43

APPROVAL OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO COORDINATE INVESTIGATIONS OF GROUNDWATER FOR TOXIC SUBSTANCES

WHEREAS:

- Toxic pollutants pose a threat to California groundwaters.
- Current groundwater monitoring activities overlap and duplicate each other.
- 3. Coordination of groundwater toxics investigations by the State Water Resources Control Board, Department of Food and Agriculture, Department of Health Services, and the Department of Water Resources will ensure efficient use of scarce funds, staffing, and other resources.
- 4. The Memorandum of Understanding will facilitate the necessary coordination of groundwater toxics investigations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Approves the Memorandum of Understanding to Coordinate Investigations of Groundwater for Toxic Substances.
- 2. Authorizes the Chairwoman to sign this MOU for the State Board.
- 3. Directs staff to request approval by the other signatory agencies.
