## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-55

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR WELL DRILLING AND GEOLOGICAL INVESTIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF THE AEROJET SITE, RANCHO CORDOVA, CALIFORNIA

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board), has discovered widespread groundwater contamination in Eastern Sacramento County on and near land owned by the Aerojet-General Corporation;
- 2. The Regional Board has issued cease and desist orders to Aerojet-General Corporation and has referred the case to the Attorney General for civil monetary remedies;
- The Regional Board has identified and monitored existing wells in the area and collected a considerable amount of data regarding the quality of the groundwaters in Eastern Sacramento County;
- 4. The Regional Board has found that the data collected from existing wells in Eastern Sacramento County is insufficient to fully document the horizontal and vertical extent of such groundwater pollution, and well logs for existing wells are insufficient to fully document site geology, it is necessary to drill a selected number of monitoring wells at specific locations to fill data gaps that currently exist.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a Standard Agreement for well drilling and monitoring in an amount not to exceed \$296,860, fiscal year 1980-81 funds, for a period of six months.
