STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-62

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXTEND A CONTRACT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DAVIS, FOR A STUDY OF AQUACULTURE AS AN ALTERNATIVE WASTEWATER TREATMENT TECHNIQUE

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Board has agreed to support a three-year program to evaluate the applicability of aquaculture as an alternative wastewater technique.
- 2. The first two years of study under Contract No. 8-131-400 have shown the technique to be feasible and cost effective, especially for small communities.
- 3. The third year is needed to conduct larger scale studies to resolve basis issues of hydraulics and biochemical responses of aquaculture systems that exist now and have been raised by various demonstration studies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board authorize the Executive Director to extend and augment Contract No. 8-131-400 with the University of California, Davis, to continue a study of aquaculture as an alternative wastewater treatment technique in an amount not to exceed \$140,000 and for a duration not to exceed one year.
