STATE WATER RESOURCE CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 81-80

APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION'S PHASE II 208 WORKPLAN FOR COUNTY STUDIES, MINING, AND WATER QUALITY PROBLEM ASSESSMENT PROJECTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for supervising 208 planning under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act as amended (PL 92-500).
- 2. The State Board approved a Phase II 208 workplan for the Central Valley Region (Region 5).
- 3. Region 5 staff proposes to revise the County Studies, Mining, and Water Quality Problem Assessment portions of this workplan as follows:
 - o delete Alpine, Amador, Lake, and Yuba Counties from the County Studies lists;
 - o delete Georgetown RCD from the County Studies list;
 - o delete the \$20,000 contract with the SCS for an IPA and make the \$20,000 available for redirection;
 - o add Butte County to the County Studies list;
 - o reduce Region 5 administrative staff funding from \$88,000 to \$58,000 and make the \$30,000 available for redirection;
 - o reduce County contracts studies funding from \$150,000 to \$125,000 and make the \$25,000 available for redirection;
 - o delete the State Board participation in the Water Quality Problem Assessment and make the \$80,000 available for redirection; and
 - o add the Pollution Abatement Action Plan contract for Shasta King Mine portals to the mining workplan and fund it with \$50,000 of the 208 funds listed above as available for redirection;
- 4. State Board staff proposes to redirect to the Special Projects 208 Program Administration project the \$105,000 made available by the proposed workplan revision.
- 5. The State Board has considered comments pertaining to the proposed workplan revisions at its August 20, 1981, meeting.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- Approves the proposed changes to the Phase II 208 Central Valley Region workplan for County Studies, Mining, and Water Quality Problem Assessment.
- 2. Reallocates the remaining \$105,000 of the Central Valley Phase II 208 funds to the State Board's 208 Program Administration project.
- Directs the Executive Director to transmit the revised workplan to EPA and requests EPA approval of the revisions.
