CERTIFICATION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE
ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS
208 WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS:


1. The Association of Bay Area Governments submitted amendments to its Environmental Management Plan to the State Water Resources Control Board for certification in 1981;
2. The State Water Resources Control Board certified all but two of the amendments by Resolution No. 81-101;
3. The amendments not certified consisted of the 20-year needs list of facilities and Policy Action 5.3, which recommends that the Association of Bay Area Governments and the Regional Board consolidate the preparation of the 20-year facilities list;
4. The 20-year facilities list was not certified because it was out of date, and Policy Action 5.3 was not certified because it did not identify local funds as a source of financing the recommended policy action;
5. The Association of Bay Area Governments revised the two proposed amendments and in Resolution No. 82-1, adopted the revised amendments after public hearings on May 27 and June 2, 1982;
6. The Association of Bay Area Governments has submitted the revised amendments to the State Water Resources Control Board for certification;
7. The revisions to the 20-year facilities needs list complies with Resolution No. 81-101, and meets the requirements and criteria of Section 208 of PL 95-217 and the appropriate federal regulations, and
8. The revisions to Policy Action 5.3 does not comply with Resolution No. 81-101 and does not meet the requirements and criteria of Section 208 of PL 95-217 and the appropriate federal regulations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board certifies the 20-year facilities needs list as an amendment to Chapter III of the San Francisco Bay Area Environmental Management Plan; and
2. That the State Board remands Policy Action 5.3 to ABAG for revision to add local funds as a funding source for the preparation of the 20-year facilities list.
3. That the State Board directs the Executive Director to submit the certified amendments to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for approval.
