Resolution No. 83-69

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT A SECTION 104(g)(1) GRANT FROM THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ACTIVITIES OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL INSTITUTE

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board wishes to continue the operator training activities of the Water Quality Control Institute.
2. Section 104(g)(1) of the Clean Water Act allows funding for the purpose of providing an adequate supply of trained personnel to operate and maintain existing and future treatment works.
3. Curricula at the Water Quality Control Institute needs updating.
4. A grant application has been submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency for \$103,000 to fund WQCI curricula and updating.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to accept a Section 104(g)(1) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency when it is awarded.
