STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87- 18

ADDITION OF NEW PROJECT TO FY 1987 PRIORITY LIST MARINA COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, PROJECT NO. C-06-2972-11

WHEREAS:

- The Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board has established a "zone of prohibition" against waste discharges into Monterey Bay.
- The Marina Wastewater Treatment Facility, in accordance with Cease and Desist Order No. 79-07, must cease its discharge to the established "zone of prohibition".
- 3. The Marina project is a "new project" affected by the Board policy established on September 2, 1982 prohibiting the addition of new projects to the Priority List except when a public health emergency exists.
- 4. There has been no documentation submitted indicating that a public health emergency exists.
- 5. Marina should be allowed to compete for grant assistance to eliminate their discharge to the "zone of prohibition".

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The State Board waives its September 2, 1982 policy for the Marina County Water District project.
- That a new project for the Marina County Water District is added to the FY 1987 Clean Water Grant Priority List with funding scheduled in FY 1988.
