STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 87-87

DIRECTING THE MAMMOTH COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO TAKE SPECIFIC ACTIONS TO INSURE FUTURE COMPLIANCE WITH FISHERY FLOW RELEASE REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS:

- 1. The Mammoth County Water District (District) has had a continuing problem for the last 30 years finding adequate water supplies to meet increasing demand within the District's service area.
- 2. Recently the District has had problems meeting by-pass requirements in Permit 17332 (Application 25368).
- 3. The District maintains it cannot utilize its full entitlement (2,760 acrefeet per annum) due to operational constraints, master operational agreement with the United States Forest Service, and by-pass requirements in Permit 17332 (Application 25368) if precipitation is less than 100 percent of normal.
- 4. The District maintains that it is now working diligently to implement conservation measures to reduce the demand on surface waters from Mammoth Creek.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The District shall come before the Board, on or prior to the April 1988 Board workshop, with a written report and an oral presentation regarding its ability to continue to meet the by-pass requirements specified in Permit 17332 (Application 25368) without additional regulatory action by the Board. The report and presentation shall address the following subjects:

- Anticipated demands of the District both current and future to projected maximum development.
- Existing quantities of water (both average and maximum safe yield during the driest year on record) presently available to the District from surface, ground water, or other sources.
- 3. Steps to be taken by the District to curtail demand, or augment supply, or a combination thereof; if the future projected District demands will exceed existing available supplies.

If the District fails to come before the Board on or before the April 1988 Board workshop, the Division of Water Rights may initiate an enforcement action against the District in order to prevent any future violations of by-pass flow requirements from occurring.
