APPROVAL OF A POLICY FOR IMPLEMENTING THE
STATE REVOLVING FUND FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS

WHEREAS:


1. The Water Quality Act of 1987 (Act) authorized federal monies to create State Revolving Fund (SRF) Loan Programs for funding construction of publicly-owned treatment works.
2. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) approved a Concept Paper on November 17, 1987, for Conversion to the State Revolving Fund Loan Program which addressed the development of the loan program for construction of wastewater treatments projects.
3. The State Board intends to implement the loan program initially using policy and then adopt regulations after evaluating the effectiveness of the program.
4. The State Board has reviewed and considered the Draft Policy for Implementating the State Revolving Fund Program for construction of wastewater treatment works dated September 1988.

THEREFORE BE IS RESOLVED:

That the State Board approves the Final Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund Program for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Works dated September 1988.
