WHEREAS:

- The Environmental Protection Agency has requested that the State Water Resources Control Board consider increasing C-06-1124-120 for the City of Watsonville (City);
- The City has anticipated a cost overrun due mainly to a contractor's claim; and
- The final eligible cost have not been determined.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

- 1. Reserves \$4,272,877 in Environmental Protection Agency grant funds until such time as the final eligible cost are known on C-06-1128-120; and
- When the final eligible cost are known, the Board will consider increasing the City's grant.
