

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 91-73

AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN  
THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY WATER AUTHORITY (AUTHORITY) AND  
THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD (STATE BOARD)  
TO PROVIDE RESOURCES TO ASSIST THE  
CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD,  
SAN DIEGO REGION (SAN DIEGO REGIONAL BOARD) STAFF  
WITH GENERAL WATER RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS:

1. The San Diego County Water Authority and the Regional Board share common goals in increasing the use of reclaimed water in the San Diego region.
2. A Memorandum of Understanding exists between the San Diego County Water Authority and the Regional Board for the purpose of establishing a cooperative and coordinated framework for general water reclamation activities within the Regional Board.
3. A significant backlog of work currently exists in processing proposals for reclamation projects resulting in delays for many project proponents.
4. The time available for Regional Board staff to process permits and requirements and to prepare proposed Basin Plan amendments for reclamation projects is limited by available budgeted resources.
5. The Authority has offered to fund two additional staff positions at the Regional Board for a period of two years to work on reclamation projects.
6. Augmenting existing Regional Board staff resources dedicated to reclamation projects will benefit the people of the State of California in general, and the residents and water users within the San Diego region in particular.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:


That the State Board:

1. Authorizes the Executive Director to contract with the Authority in an amount not to exceed \$280,874 to fund two Regional Board staff positions for a period of two years to perform work on reclamation projects.
2. Directs that the staff positions funded from these resources shall be totally under the direction of the Regional Board.

3. Requests the Regional Board to provide a report to the State Board upon completion of the contract period which identifies the benefits of this effort.
