RESOLUTION NO. 91-90

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR
THE CITY OF OAKLAND, BASIN 54
RELIEF SEWER PHASE IIIA AND IIIB

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
2. The State Board on September 20, 1990, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1991 SRF Loan Program Priority List and which includes the City of Oakland's Basin 54 Relief Sewer, Phase IIIA and IIIB project;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the Basin 54 Relief Sewer, Phase IIIA and IIIB; and
4. The information contained in the East Bay Municipal Utilities District (EBMUD) Environmental Impact Report (State Clearinghouse No. 85110505), and the Environmental Protection Agency's Finding of No Significant Impact (February 24, 1987) has been reviewed and considered, and it has been determined that:

(A) Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR with respect to the following aspects of the project: (1) groundwater impacts will be mitigated by conforming to Regional Board discharge requirements; (2) floodplain impacts will be mitigated by proper construction techniques and timing, and restoration of channels and streams; (3) impacts to vegetation and sensitive areas will be mitigated by avoidance and replacement as outlined in the EIR; (4) geological impacts will be mitigated by conducting site specific investigations and using proper construction techniques outlined in the EIR to minimize soil or slope stability.


(B) With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves the Basin 54 Relief Sewer for a SRF loan of \$5.7 million, with a repayment period of 20 years, and the first repayment due one year after completion of construction.
