RESOLUTION NO. 91-100

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR  
THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO (CITY)  
SUNNYDALE FACILITIES

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990;
2. The State Board on September 26, 1991, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 1992 SRF Loan Program Priority List and approved the FFY 1992 SRF Intended Use Plan;
3. The State Board, on September 26, 1991, approved funding in FFY 1992 for construction of new collection systems and combined sewer overflow correction problems;
4. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and the revenue program for the City and County of San Francisco Sunnydale Facilities project; and
5. The information contained in the mitigated Negative Declaration (State Clearinghouse No. 87052625) prepared for the project has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that:
  - A. Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Initial Study for the Negative Declaration, with respect to the following aspects of the project: (1) water quality impacts will be mitigated by providing sedimentation tanks as necessary for dewatering, properly disposing of any contaminated water and reducing sediment dispersion by enclosing the excavation area; (2) biological impacts will be mitigated by reestablishing clam habitat and revegetating natural areas disturbed by construction; and (3) cultural resource impacts will be mitigated by taking any action necessary to mitigate potential impacts, including stopping construction, and by retaining an archeological investigator for advice on identification of sensitive resources, recommendations for mitigation, and preparation of reports.
  - B. With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the Negative Declaration, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approve an SRF loan of \$4.1 million for the San Francisco Sunnydale Facilities, Project No. C-06-4025-310, with a repayment period of 20 years and the first repayment due one (1) year after the first loan disbursement.
