STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 94-4

APPROVAL OF STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE CITY OF BLYTHE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION AND DENITRIFICATION PROJECT

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" and amended it on September 20, 1990 and on January 21, 1993;
- The State Water Board, on September 23, 1993, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year 1994 State Revolving Fund Loan Program Priority List which includes the City of Blythe Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion and Denitrification Project;
- 3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report and the draft revenue program for the subject project; and
- 4. The City of Blythe approved and adopted a Negative Declaration (State Clearinghouse No. 92112048) prepared for the project, which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that the proposed project will not result in any significant negative environmental impacts.
- 5. Upon receipt of California's FFY 1994 SRF capitalization grant, the State Water Board will have sufficient SRF loan funds to make a SRF loan of \$6.9 million to the City of Blythe.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Subject to receipt of the FFY 1994 SRF capitalization grant, the State Water Board approves a SRF loan of \$6.9 million for the City of Blythe with a repayment period of twenty (20) years for the project and the first repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.




FIGURE 2-1 BLYTHE VICINITY MAP
