

APPOINTMENT OF ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE BAY PROTECTION AND TOXIC CLEANUP PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. California Water Code Section 13394.6(a) requires the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to establish an advisory committee to assist in the implementation of Chapter 5.6 of Division Seven of the Water Code (Bay Protection and Toxic Cleanup). Members are required to come from the following interests: trade associations, dischargers that pay Bay Protection and Toxic Cleanup Program (BPTCP) fees, environmental, public interest, public health, and wildlife conservation organizations.
- 2. The Water Code authorizes the committee to provide the SWRCB with advice on how BPTCP information should be interpreted and used in the implementation of Chapter 5.6.
- 3. The chairperson of the advisory committee shall convene meetings of the committee every three months in any calendar year or as determined necessary by the advisory committee and approved by the SWRCB Executive Director. The members of the advisory committee shall serve without compensation.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Appoints the following individuals to the BPTCP Advisory Committee pursuant to Water Code Section 13394.6(a).
