STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 95-28

APPROVAL OF \$2,000,000 FROM THE CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT (CAA) TO FUND THE SPILLS, LEAKS, INVESTIGATION AND CLEANUP (SLIC) REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

- 1. Section 13304 Water Code authorizes the Regional Water Quality Control Boards to recover the costs of cleanup and abatement activities from persons who discharged or threaten to discharge waste;
- Regional Water Quality Control Boards expect to incur cleanup oversight costs of up to \$2,000,000 annually;
- 3. \$2,000,000 from the CAA can be used to cover up-front cleanup oversight costs at SLIC sites;
- 4. Funds recovered from dischargers will replenish the CAA.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board hereby authorizes the Chief of the Division of Clean Water Programs to encumber up to \$2,000,000 from the CAA to fund State and Regional Water Board staff costs associated with cleanup oversight at SLIC sites once such sites have been identified.
