RESOLUTION NO. 95-31

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN TO  
THE CITY OF SOUTH LAKE TAHOE  
(LOAN NO. C-06-6025-110)

WHEREAS:

1. The City of South Lake Tahoe (City) has requested a 20-year \$1,435,000 State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan for the Stateline Erosion Control Project (Project).
2. The Project has been approved for partial funding with a grant from the State Assistance Program.
3. The Project will address nonpoint source pollution causing degradation of storm water from oil, grease, salts, heavy metals and sediments draining into Lake Tahoe.
4. The Project is part of the Redevelopment Plan for the City.
5. The Project complies with the Water Quality Control Plan for the Lake Tahoe Basin and the Lake Tahoe Basin Water Quality Plan.
6. The City completed a Negative Declaration to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act on August 10, 1989.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves an SRF loan of \$1,435,000 with a 20-year term for the City.
