RESOLUTION NO. 95-72

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR HIS  
DESIGNEE TO APPROVE THE REPORT TITLED  
"INITIATIVES IN NONPOINT SOURCE MANAGEMENT"

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) initiated a comprehensive review of the Nonpoint Source Program in April 1994.
2. Ten Technical Advisory Committees were established to review management of nonpoint sources for irrigated agriculture, nutrient application, pesticide application, confined animal facilities, grazing, abandoned mines, urban runoff, hydromodification and wetlands, on-site sewage disposal, and boating and marinas.
3. The Technical Advisory Committees presented their recommendations to the SWRCB in January 1996.
4. The staff of the SWRCB's Division of Water Quality have reviewed the Technical Advisory Committees' recommendations and have prepared the report titled "Initiatives in Nonpoint Source Management".


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The SWRCB:

1. Approves the report "Initiatives in Nonpoint Source Management".
2. Directs the Executive Director to implement the recommendations contained in the report through the SWRCB and the Regional Water Quality Control Boards' (RWQCBs) workplans contingent on the availability of funding and SWRCB and RWQCB priorities.
