## STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 96-023

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT (IA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL (DSTC) FOR THE REGIONAL AND STATE BOARDS TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL SUPPORT FOR SITE REMEDIATION AT UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE (DoD) FACILITIES

## WHEREAS:

- 1. The SWRCB has been funded previously through cooperative agreements by DoD and has actively participated in the DoD Environmental Restoration Program.
- Cal/EPA Secretary James Strock has designated the DTSC to be the lead agency at military facilities and to be the sole recipient of funding through DoD Cooperative Agreements.
- 3. DTSC will provide DoD funding to the SWRCB through an IA to ensure water quality concerns are addressed in remedial actions at military bases.
- 4. Approval of this IA will ensure that there will be coordinated state agency oversight of the DoD facility cleanup activities, including those activities at closing bases.

## THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board:

Authorizes the Executive Director to execute an approximately \$10 million, two-year IA with DTSC for oversight of the cleanup of military facilities during FYs 1996-97 and 1997-98.
