STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2001-026

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, LAWRENCE LIVERMORE NATIONAL LABORATORIES OR ANOTHER PUBLIC AGENCY FOR AMBIENT GROUNDWATER MONITORING

WHEREAS:

- 1. The mission of the State Water Resources Control Board is to preserve and enhance the quality of California's water resources, and ensure their proper allocation and efficient use for the benefit of present and future generations.
- 2. Ambient water quality monitoring provides valuable information to assess the potential impacts of pollutants on the beneficial uses of water.
- 3. Expenditure authority for this agreement is included in the budget.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board authorizes the Executive Director or his designee to enter into an agreement, not to exceed \$2,245,000, and any amendments thereto, with the U.S. Geological Survey, Lawrence Livermore National Laboratories or another public agency to conduct ambient groundwater monitoring.
