STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2006 – 0001

AMENDING THE CLEAN BEACHES INITIATIVES (CBI) GRANT PROGRAM COMPETITIVE LOCATION LIST

WHEREAS:

- The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) adopted Resolution No. 2005-028 establishing the CBI Grant Program Competitive Location List (CLL) based on input from the Clean Beaches Task Force (CBTF), and the coastal Regional Water Quality Control Boards;
- 2. The CBTF recommended that the CLL be amended to add Paradise Cove; and
- 3. The CBTF recommended additional beaches be added to the CLL by the Chief of the Division of Financial Assistance (Division) if it meets the following criteria:
 - a) High frequency (>4 percent) of bacterial standard exceedences during AB 411 time periods [as specified in Health and Safety Code, Section 115880 (AB 411, Statutes of 1997, Chapter 765)];
 - b) A known public health threat or source of human sewage discharge to ocean waters adjacent to a beach;
 - c) The beach received a grade of "C", "D", or "F" on Heal the Bay's report card at least once during the previous three AB 411 time periods; and
 - d) Demonstrated bacterial contamination problems.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board:

- 1. Amends the CLL to add Paradise Cove; and
- 2. Authorizes the Chief of the Division to add beaches to the CLL for eligible projects under the CBI Grant program funded by AB 2534 that meet the following criteria:
 - a) High frequency (>4 percent) of bacterial standard exceedences during weekly monitoring of coastal waters;
 - b) A known public health threat or source of human sewage discharge to ocean waters adjacent to a beach;
 - c) The beach received a grade of "C", "D", or "F" on Heal the Bay's report card at least once during the previous three AB 411 time periods (April 1 to October 31); and
 - d) Demonstrated bacterial contamination problems.
