BY THE BOARD:

Las Virgenes Municipal Water District, hereinafter referred to as the petitioner, has submitted a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board, hereinafter referred to as the State Board, requesting review of Order No. 76-27 (NPDES Permit No. CA0056014) of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region. The petition requests that the State Board stay the effect of Order No. 76-27.

The State Board finds that:

- 1. The petition raises issues appropriate for review.
- 2. The petition does not establish lack of substantial harm to interested persons or to public interest if a stay is granted, nor immediate substantial harm to the petitioner or to the public interest if a stay is not immediately granted.
- 3. The granting of a stay under the circumstances in-volved in this matter, could be construed as permitting a discharge subject to the NPDES permit program, without compliance with state and federal laws, rules, and regulations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The issues raised by the petitioner be reviewed, and
- 2. The stay of Order No. 76-27 requested by petitioner be denied without prejudice.
