BY THE BOARD:

The City of San Clemente, hereafter referred to as petitioner, has submitted a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board, hereafter referred to as the State Board, requesting review of Order No. 76-37, a cease and desist order adopted by the San Diego Regional Board on July 26, 1976. Order No. 76-37 contains a prohibition against new connections to the sewer system of the petitioner. In addition to other relief, the petition requests that the State Board stay the effect of Order No. 76-37.

The State Board finds that:

- 1. The petition raises issues appropriate for review.
- 2. The petition does not adequately establish lack of substantial harm to interested persons or to the public interest if a stay is granted.



IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The petition raises issues appropriate for review, and the stay of Order No. 76-37 requested by the petitioner is denied.
