SACRAMENTO COUNTY

The Boeing Company, along with Aerojet-General Corporation, is in the process of installing a groundwater extraction and treatment system to control the leading edge of a plume of perchlorate and trichloroethylene (TCE) in groundwater emanating from the Inactive Rancho Cordova Test Site in eastern Sacramento County. In addition, two private wells, an agricultural well currently used for supplying water for construction of the Sunrise Douglas Development and a well at the Cordova Shooting Center used for landscape irrigation, have been found to contain low levels of TCE. Boeing will be installing treatment systems to remove TCE from the water prior to its being used. The discharge of up to 250 gallons per minute (gpm) from the Gun Club Well and 700 gpm from the Agricultural well will meet all drinking water standards and will be only used for non-potable purposes

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed informal hearing item must submit evidence, if any, or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **2 September 2005**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **2 September 2005** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All interested persons may speak at the Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony will be limited in time by the Board Chair.

An objection by a party, either in writing or at the time of the hearing, to the decision to hold an **informal** hearing shall be resolved by the Board Chair before going ahead under the informal procedure. Failure to make a timely objection to the use of informal hearing procedures before those procedures are used will constitute consent to an informal hearing.
