SUBJECT: City of Manteca, Wastewater Quality Control Facility, San Joaquin County

BOARD ACTION: *Consideration of Resolution Approving Pretreatment Program*

BACKGROUND: The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) promulgated General Pretreatment Regulations for Existing and New Sources of Pollution, codified in Title 40, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 403. The State Water Resources Control Board and Regional Water Quality Control Boards received approval authority from the USEPA to administer the General Pretreatment Regulations on 25 September 1989.

On 29 March 2004, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-2004-0028, NPDES No. CA0081558, (Order) for the City of Manteca Wastewater Quality Control Facility. The Order requires that the City of Manteca implement and comply with all pretreatment requirements contained in 40 CFR, Part 403, including implementing the necessary legal authorities.

The City of Manteca requested approval of its Industrial Pretreatment Program in accordance with 40 CFR, Part 403.9, et seq, and Provision H.21. of the Order. A resolution is proposed approving the Industrial Pretreatment Program.
