

NORCAL WASTE SYSTEMS OSTROM ROAD LANDFILL, INC., OSTROM ROAD CLASS II SOLID WASTE LANDFILL FACILITY, CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND CORRECTIVE ACTION, Yuba County

The Ostrom Road Landfill is an active Class II landfill facility located in an unincorporated area in Yuba County approximately 14 miles southeast of Marysville. The facility is owned and operated by Norcal Waste System Ostrom Road Landfill, Inc. The facility accepts municipal solid wastes and designated wastes. The facility has been in operation since 1995, and to date, approximately 52 acres out of a total landfill development of 221 acres have been constructed and approved for operation.

The waste discharge requirements (WDRs) are being revised due to a request from the Discharger to modify the requirements for the maximum allowable depth of leachate on the liner system. The previous requirement of no more than 12 inches of leachate as measured from the bottom of the sump was causing the leachate pumps to fail due to excessive cycling. The revised specification allows leachate to be no greater than the depth of the sump, plus three inches. This will allow for safe pump operation as required by Title 27, CCR. The Findings in the WDRs have also been updated to reflect current status and operations at the facility.

Surface water drainage from the site is toward Best Slough and Hutchinson Creek which flow into the Sacramento River. (WLB)
