The University of California, Davis (Discharger) owns and operates the Center for Aquatic Biology and Aquaculture (CABA), a fish research facility. The CABA facilities discharge disinfected effluent to the South Fork of Putah Creek. The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0083348) and Monitoring and Reporting Program Order serve as an NPDES permit renewal to the existing Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R5-99-017.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) meeting scheduled for:

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have the following rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **18 October 2006**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item and/or the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements, and Monitoring and Reporting Order must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **21 September 2006**. Written evidence or comments submitted after

**21 September 2006** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
