Thomas V. Fogarty and Mary R. Fogarty, Trustees of the Thomas V. and Mary R. Fogarty Revocable Trust dated 25 January 2000, currently own and operate Humboldt Road Private Properties Operational Unit (Unit) on part of Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 011-500-138 (formerly APN 011-030-138). These Waste Discharge Requirements are being revised to require post-closure maintenance of the Unit.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **15 February 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on **15 January 2008**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by noon on

15 February 2008. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **15 February 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
