**PUBLIC HEARING**

Tentative Waste Discharge Requirements  
(National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0078093)  
and Adoption of Cease and Desist Order  
for

**CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION  
DEUEL VOCATIONAL INSTITUTION  
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (hereinafter Discharger) is the owner and operator of a wastewater collection, treatment, and disposal system, and provides sewerage service to the Deuel Vocational Institution (hereinafter Facility), a California prison facility. The Facility is serviced by a sanitary wastewater treatment plant that discharges treated domestic wastewater to Deuel Drain, a tributary to the San Joaquin River via Paradise Cut and the Old River within the Sacramento – San Joaquin Delta, a water of the United States. The Discharger also discharges industrial storm water from Discharge Point No. 003 and industrial storm water commingled with contaminated groundwater from Discharge Point No. 004 to Deuel Drain. The proposed permit includes effluent limitations for nitrate, electrical conductivity, bromoform, chlorodibromomethane, and dichlorobromomethane with which the Discharger can not immediately comply. Therefore, a cease and desist order is proposed to provide a time schedule for compliance with these effluent limitations.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Staff of Central Valley Regional Board
- California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Deuel Vocational Institution

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons

may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **10 October 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Orders were issued on **22 August 2008**. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than by 5:00 pm on **26 September 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 pm on **26 September 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
