NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES)
PERMIT NO. CA0083551**

for

**TRUSTEES OF U.A. LOCAL 38 CONVALESCENT TRUST FUND
KONOCTI HARBOR RESORT AND SPA
LAKE COUNTY**

The Trustees of U.A. Local 38 Convalescent Trust Fund (Discharger) owns and operates a collection system and wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) that provides sewage service to the Konocti Harbor Resort and Spa. The Discharger also owns and operates a cooling tower. The Discharger notified the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) that it has ceased discharging non-contact cooling water to Clear Lake as of 17 January 2003. The Discharger is currently discharging WWTP effluent to its land disposal system under WDRs Order No. R5-2002-0157. By ceasing its surface water discharge as of 17 January 2003, as required by Cease and Desist Order (CDO) No. R5-2002-0158, the NPDES portion of Order No. R5-2002-0157 and CDO No. R5-2002-0158 are no longer needed.

The Regional Water Board will consider adoption of this Resolution to amend the Discharger's existing WDR Order No. R5-2002-0157. The Resolution proposes to rescind the NPDES Permit No. CA0083551 portion of the WDRs and proposes to rescind CDO No. R5-2002-0158 in its entirety. The portion of WDRs Order No. R5-2002-0157 that regulates the Discharger's discharge of WWTP effluent to land will remain in effect until the Regional Water Board considers adopting revised WDRs at a later date.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

- Trustees of U.A. Local 38 Convalescent Trust Fund Representatives

Only designated parties will have the following rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are

interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **14 September 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and, in particular, how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this hearing item must submit testimony, evidence, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than 5:00 p.m. on **14 September 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 p.m. on **14 September 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
