**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
concerning

**RENEWAL OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (NPDES No. CA0077828)  
AND TENTATIVE TIME SCHEDULE ORDER  
AND RECISSION OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER NO. R5-2002-0094  
FOR  
NEVADA COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 1  
LAKE WILDWOOD WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
NEVADA COUNTY**

Nevada County Sanitation District No. 1 (Discharger) owns and operates the Lake Wildwood Wastewater Treatment Plant, which provides treatment for up to 1.12 million gallons per day (mgd) of domestic wastewater from the community of Lake Wildwood and Wildwood Estates Subdivisions. The Facility discharges tertiary treated wastewater to Deer Creek, a water of the United States, and a tributary to the Yuba River.

The Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) will consider renewal of the Discharger's existing NPDES Permit, proposing new or more restrictive effluent limitations for BOD, TSS, ammonia, dibromochloromethane, dichlorobromomethane, and pH. The Discharger is unable to immediately comply with the new effluent limitations for dibromochloromethane and dichlorobromomethane. A tentative Time Schedule Order is proposed to provide a schedule for compliance.

On 7 June 2002 the Regional Water Board adopted Cease and Desist No. R5-2002-0094, which provided a time schedule for the Discharger to comply with effluent limitations for ammonia, nitrate and nitrite by 30 April 2007. The Discharger completed construction of treatment plant upgrades to insure compliance with existing and proposed effluent limitations for ammonia, nitrate and nitrite. Compliance has been achieved and the Cease and Desist Order is no longer needed.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are

interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 11 January 2009**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

The tentative Waste Discharge Requirements were issued on 12 December 2008. Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 11 January 2009**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5:00 p.m. on 11 January 2009** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
