**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

TENTATIVE REVISED WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
FOR  
CALAVERAS COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS  
ROCK CREEK SOLID WASTE FACILITY  
CLASS II LANDFILL  
CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENT  
CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, CLOSURE, AND POST-CLOSURE MAINTENANCE  
CALAVERAS COUNTY

Calaveras County Department of Public Works submitted an 18 October 2010 *Phase I Partial Final Closure and Postclosure Maintenance Plan* for closure of the Phase IA and Phase IB areas of the landfill at the Rock Creek Solid Waste Facility near Milton. The closure plan proposes an engineered alternative final cover for the landfill that requires revision of the facility's waste discharge requirements for approval. The engineered alternative final cover consists of, from bottom to top, an 18-inch soil foundation layer, a 40-mil geomembrane, a geocomposite drainage layer, and an 18-inch soil vegetative layer. Further information about the proposed final cover, the facility, and the proposed requirements can be found in the Findings and the Information Sheet of the tentative WDRs that are available on the Central Valley Water Board's website at [www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board\\_decisions/tentative\\_orders](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/centralvalley/board_decisions/tentative_orders).

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **24 February 2011**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than by noon on **24 February 2011**. Written materials submitted after noon on **24 February 2011** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair
