TENTATIVE WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR BUTTE COUNTY NEAL ROAD CLASS III MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILL AND CLASS II SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS BUTTE COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is the tentative Waste Discharge Requirements for the Butte County Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill and Class II Surface Impoundments in Butte County. To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you may have concerning the revisions to the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 11 May 2011**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Orders at its 8,9,10 June 2011 Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 11 April 2011** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by 15 April 2011. To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the discharger only.
